LCS HOME AND SCHOOL MISSION

It is the mission of the LCS Home and School Association to support the school and all of those within through fundraising, volunteer coordination and parental/parish involvement. Every parent/guardian of a child at LCS is automatically a member of the Home and School Association. At registration, each K-8 school family is responsible for paying an activity fee (Preschool and Pre-K students the fee is optional).

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

President – serves one-year term. Oversees the LCS Home and School Association.

President Ex-Officio – serves one-year term following the presidency as an advisor. This is a non-voting position. Responsible for ensuring the Starry Night Fundraiser funds are spent as planned.

The President-Elect – serves as vice president and will move to the president position the following year. Serves as liaison to fundraising committees.

Treasurer – serves a one-year term with a maximum of two consecutive terms. This individual prepares the annual budget, maintains records of all receipts and expenditures, and reports monthly on the budget.

Treasurer-Elect – serves a one-year term and will move to the Treasurer position the following year.

Secretary – serves a two-year term with a maximum of one consecutive term. Provides and distributes minutes from monthly LCS Home and School Executive Committee meetings.

Room Parent Coordinator(s) – serves a one-year term that is renewable. Assigns room parents to classrooms in the fall, serves as liaison between Principal and room parents, updates room parent notebooks, and coordinates the teacher and staff birthday gifts/parties and the holiday parties.

Volunteer Coordinator(s) – serves one-year term that is renewable. Recruits volunteers as needed for various committees/events, coordinates the used uniform sales and oversees Unpack Your Backpack and Open House Night.

Publicity Chair – serves one-year term that is renewable. Publishes monthly Home and School newsletter and oversees social media sites.

New Family Ambassador(s) – serves one-year term that is renewable. Helps welcome new families to Lourdes via new family events, pair new families with another LCS 'Buddy Family' and answer questions.

Hospitality Coordinator(s) – serves one-year term that is renewable. Organizes all hospitality events for LCS such as Welcome Coffee, teacher/staff luncheons and Buddy Lunch.

FUNDRAISING

SCRIP – This is an on-going fundraiser where gift cards are purchased from local and national merchants. There is no extra cost associated with purchasing Scrip. The companies and stores donate a percentage back to the school. This percentage can be anywhere from 2% to 50% depending on the vendor. **We encourage all families to take advantage of the SCRIP program!**

Corporate Income - General Mills box tops are collected throughout the year. We also receive a % of sales from Amazon Smiles Program from all orders on Amazon.com.

Spirit Wear – A portion of all sales go to Lourdes.

1st Day School Supplies – A portion of all sales to Lourdes.

Lourdes Starry Night – Lourdes' largest annual fundraising event! This school and parish event raised over \$60,000 in the 2016/2017 school year!
