Superiors who were not solicitous for the salvation of those entrusted to them. Those who strove for worldly riches and pleasures, The worldly-minded, who failed to use their wealth and talents in the service of God, Those who witnessed the death of others, but would not think of their own, Those who did not provide for the life here-after, Those whose sentence is sever because of great things entrusted to them, The popes, kings, rulers, bishops, and their counselors, The priests and religious of the Catholic church and all defenders of the holy faith.
