


## A Year in Review July 2021 - 2022


- Our parish has weathered the storm of the Pandemic rather well and we remain strong in faith and participation. We are down in numbers as some people are still hesitant to attend Mass or social gatherings, but our ability to live stream and share the parish events has really been a blessing for many people.
- While it is encouraging news that we are financially stable, we still need to improve on envelope giving. Our offertory has remained stagnant despite inflation and we need to work on increasing it.
- I am very thankful that the parish offers a wide variety of ministries in Encountering, Growing, and Serving Christ and our neighbors. Our newest endeavor this year, moving Religious Education to Sundays between the two morning Masses has seen great success, especially as we invite more people to attend fellowship functions for individuals and the whole family.
- Hopefully most parishioners are aware that we have conducted several studies over the last five years looking at the future of the Catholic Church in Bettendorf. Our current facilities are very limited, and we have maxed out our ability to add on to our building with a limited acreage of about 3.5 acres. It would be more costly to upgrade our existing buildings rather than build new. The diocese suggests that modern parishes have at least 15 acres and even more with a school.
- The conclusion of the latest study supported by Bishop Zinkula and parish leadership, suggests that both parishes should pursue new land in the northeast section of Bettendorf to build a new structure to house Lourdes Catholic School and Religious Education programs that can be shared with St. John Vianney. We hope in the future to build a new church building, rectory, and other needs that we will identify. To work toward this goal, we will be working closely with you to help parish leadership determine how we should move ahead. A parishioner has generously decided to donate us the land we need, where we need it This is a wonderful gift! We will not receive the land however until we begin the project.

- The Scott County Catholic Schools committee is continuing to form a unified system for all parish schools in Scott County. The plan is to initiate a regional Catholic School System by 2023. I have been working very closely with other catholic school pastors and Mr. Andy Craig who is chairing the effort. Our ability to work within a unified system will strengthen our ability to provide academic excellence with fiscal responsibility by sharing in services and providing better support structures.
- The Diocese is raising awareness of the declining number of priests, we need to pray and support vocations to the priesthood as well as be willing to consider how we assign priests to parishes in 10 years (2030) we will have 32 active priests to serve 76 parishes in 22 counties in the Diocese. To help in that effort the diocese has recognized that we need to build funds to support future priests and to build up the retirement and medical needs of retired priests. In the future we will be looking at a Diocesan wide capitol campaign to help fund this effort. We are also working with the bishop to combine this campaign with our own needs in building a new educational site for Lourdes Catholic School and our religious educational programs, we hope this will be a joint effort with Scott County Catholic Schools and St. John Vianney.

- Assumption High School subsidy paid by parish was \$90,677 it will increase to \$110,635 2021-2022.
