Our Great Teachers – Making Lourdes Catholic School Unique!

Reading – LCS uses the Voweletics® curriculum for reading, and our goal for every student at the end of kindergarten is to be reading at or above the

first grade reading level.

Spanish – Lourdes Catholic School teaches Spanish to all grades, K-8. Lourdes students typically start in Spanish II when going on to Assumption.

Cursive – We believe in the benefits of cursive handwriting. Cursive is taught in 3rd grade and reinforced in 4th grade.

Parent / Teacher Partnership – There are countless opportunities to get involved at the school and in classrooms. Teachers encourage volunteering and even welcome younger siblings to join in too!


What: A chance to learn about the Lourdes Catholic School
