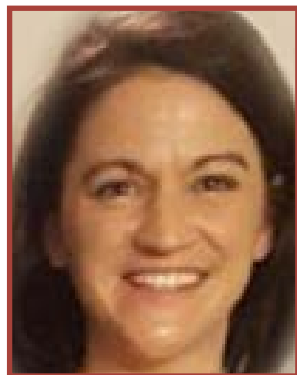

## From the Principal



Greetings, Families!

Our school year is off to a GREAT start! If you follow us on Facebook, please “like” our posts and “share” them with your friends! We want to get the word out that we LOVE our school and all of the unique things we do. I believe I speak for the entire staff when I say that we feel blessed and honored that you are entrusting your precious children to us.

Are you ever curious about what our K-8 teachers do on early-release Wednesdays, or what our Preschool & PreK teachers do on Fridays? Each K-8 teacher is a member of a Professional Learning Community (PLC), and this PLC meets from 2:45 until 3:15. Our Preschool and PreK teachers and aides have their PLC meetings on Friday afternoons. During PLC time, teachers engage in various studies:

Essential Practices for PreK (training) - Preschool and PreK PLC

Essential Practices for K-3 (training) - K-1-2 PLC

Better Than Carrots or Sticks (book study) - 3-4-5 and 6-7-8 PLC

Help for Billy (book study) - all

Everybody Needs to Forgive Somebody (book study) - all

Then, from 3:15 until 3:45, teachers meet in committees. We have 17 committees at Lourdes, and all teachers belong to at least three of them. Our Preschool & PreK teachers join in on committees after dismissal, or meet with their committees at other times.

The Board of Education (“BOE”) is the entity at LCS that functions like a public school “school board.” The meetings are open to anyone who wishes to attend. Generally, the BOE meets on the third Tuesday of every month. The next meeting will be October 15th at 6:00 PM in the LCS Library. 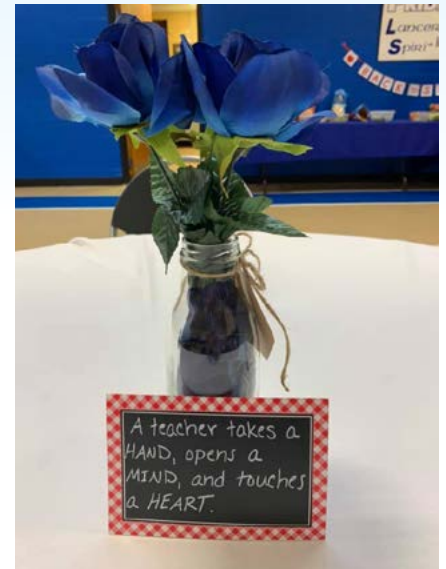

# SCRIP is available for purchase ONLINE!

As you have heard, you will now be able to order your scrip cards online! This will be a great way to grow our scrip program in order to continue to fund some important needs of our school! Click here to set up your family account.

During this process, you will be able to enter your checking account information on their secure site using PrestoPay. (Please follow the steps to verify your account.) This way, orders will come directly from your account. No need for check writing! (Note: You will not be able to use credit cards as the fees would take too much away from our rebates).

There are numerous ways to get your cards! Some examples are:

- 1) Order the actual cards, including local retailers, which will be filled by scrip coordinators once a week.
- 2) ScripNow - eGift card
- 3) Reload - reload your previous physical cards
- 4) Reload Now - reload in minutes when using your presto pay!

Plus, families can access both ScripNow and reloads on Shop-WithScrip's mobile website, MyScripWallet.com. With MyScripWallet, families can order ScripNow or reload a card, use PrestoPay when they checkout, and access their scrip right then and there on their smartphone. This means that families can shop for scrip whenever and wherever they need to, no planning ahead

necessary! MyScripWallet is supported on Apple and Android mobile devices. Just access MyScripWallet.com, login (via shop with scrip login) and you'll be ready to shop!

Don't worry, all of this information is on the website. It is very simple to navigate and discover the opportunities! This is also a great opportunity to get our friends and family ordering cards from us! Just share the link and have them set up their own account!

## Youth Ministry

Youth Ministry at Lourdes aims to engage middle school and high school students to take faith and their relationship with God to a deeper and more personal level. It calls young people to experience Jesus through a process of encounter, growth, and service and in a way that isn't simply reduced to the classroom or Mass on the weekends, but rather becomes a lived experience each and every day. Part of this process includes events and opportunities in which youth can get involved. Below is a brief explanation of some of the offerings that are ongoing or coming up soon:

**Youth Alpha** – This fall, youth (in grades 6-12) are invited to participate in a Youth Alpha Series which will run at the same time as an Alpha for adult in a separate room. Alpha is free to join and includes dinner, a short video talk, and an open and honest small group discussion around life's big questions and the basic tenants of the Christian faith. Signups are encouraged for teens and adults and the links to do so can be found at [www.lourdescatholic.com](http://www.lourdescatholic.com).

**Holy Fire, Chicago** - Holy Fire is a one-day conference that gives youth the opportunity to experience prayer, witness, joy, and fellowship as they discover their vital role as missionary disciples who are called to not only live their faith, but witness it to others. This event allows our Young Church to reflect more deeply on the gifts of the Holy Spirit through dynamic speakers, music, and the sacrament of the Eucharist. It is open to any middle school students and friends (attending Catholic schools, public schools, or homeschooled). There is still time to sign up!
