3. New Business

- a. **Principal Report** no report

- f. **March P/T Conferences.** Meals needed for teachers. Mrs. Behnke suggested Tuesday be a food heavy day, then teachers can have leftovers and lighter foods on Wednesday and Thursday. Thursday would be lighter, less clean up. Hospitality will do a signup genius for food.

g. Elections/Nominations
