1. Welcome, Opening Prayer and Introductions

Jen Foley to look into more ways to promote this to Pre-K through 7th grade school familes.

- b. **Starry Night Update** Total net income is about \$64,000 for the 2022 event. Still have some money coming in from art projects. Chrissy Hayes is coordinating with teachers to confirm the list of classroom/school needs. Special thanks to the Starry Night crew, especially Chrissy Hayes, Brooke Heckinger, Linda Mosher. Great job once again!!
- c. Budget/Scrip Update
 - i. In the checking account, Home & School checking account balance is approximately \$20,000. Katie Carroll is working on reconciling the budget/checking account with Katie Carroll. Excess funds have been carried over from a couple of years. This is a chance to level-set. Since the funds were raised by Home & School, the funds will be used for Lourdes Catholic School, with approval from Fr. Jason, and church leadership, along with a discussion with Home & School executive leadership.
 - ii. SCRIP profits are right around \$5400 for the school year. Ryan Wermes will put in some reminders about year-end gifts for teachers and there is discussion about selling SCRIP at Mass again. Perhaps a SCRIP sign up genius? SCRIP discussion about whether or not to continue with SCRIP or revamp the program (mobile only – no/limited physical cards?). Perhaps more effort into MobileCause instead, though MobileCause renewal is also being discussed by executive committee members and decision about next school year must be made.

The funds must be spent specifically for birthday buddies.

- v. <u>Last Day of School</u> Discussion about securing Kona Ice Truck on the last day. Is there anything being planned? Need to check with Jennifer Alongi to see if there is anything planned. Also need to confirm budget for this. Katie Carroll will check previous year's budgets to confirm how much was spent. Karen Moldt suggested buying ice cream treats in bulk (Costco / Sam's) and hand them out at the end of school. Middle schoolers could help hand them out. Jen Foley is on this.
