Substitutes Needed

You are a valuable asset to LCS! Lourdes is in need of substitutes. Thanks to an amazing group of current substitutes, we have been blessed to cover most positions. Luckily, we don't always need a substitute to cover a position, but there are frequent times when we must work as a team for unfilled positions.

We are in need of substitute teachers especially for short-term assignments. You do not need a teaching degree to work as a substitute teacher. A minimum of an associate's degree or 60 college degree hours from a college/university are enough to qualify as well as completing VIRTUS. The process to become a substitute teacher includes completion of a 15-20 hour workshop, multiple background checks, and applications with the Iowa Board of Education Examiners. Most workshops, such as the ones below, are now virtual:

- Dec. 12-15, 6:00p.m. 8:30 p.m.
- Jan. 10-13, 6:00p.m. 8:30 p.m.

- Feb. 6-9, 6:00p.m. 8:30 p.m.
- Mar. 7-10, 6:00p.m. 8:30 p.m.

If you are interested in subbing, but do not have those qualifications, we have a need for substitute aides as well, and aide positions only require that you have graduated high school and completed our VIRTUS requirements. All aides work in a classroom setting with a teacher as well.
