Dear Lourdes Families,

Happy New Year! It was wonderful to welcome everyone back to the building on Thursday. Today is the start of our last week of the 2nd Quarter. We are almost halfway through our school year! Please note that **Friday of this week, K-8 students will release at 11:30am**. Preschool and preK will be in session like usual all day Friday. Next Monday, January 15 is a holiday and there is NO SCHOOL for preschool, preK, K-8.

I have an important announcement about a few changes in our school calendar. Our K-8 teachers will be participating in a statewide reading initiative (LETRS <u>Science of Reading</u>) which means 2 days of professional development. This is a 2-year initiative and I am excited we were granted spots to participate.

Due to the professional development, there will be NO SCHOOL for the K-8 students on Monday, April 8 and Monday, May 6. I am also putting April 26 back on the calendar as a school day for all students, preschool through grade 8. - In some cases, SCCS may add band, algebra, and/or sport fees, as well as PSAT and/or AP test fees. (These options were not available in the 1st semester.)
