Don't lose out on funds for this next school year! If you are a parent of a Kindergarten or 1st grade student who resides in lowa, your child automatically qualifies for the ESA funds, regardless of income. *Make sure if you have been approved, you follow up and choose Lourdes Catholic School so we have the ability to bill your account for next year's tuition.*
