ESA for 2024-2025



Sign in and complete this as the income qualifications are changed to allow more than last year. If you have any questions, or need a computer to complete this process, don't hesitate to reach out to the school office! For the majority of people this should only take around 5 minutes to complete—and it's DUE THIS SUNDAY, JUNE 30. If you have any questions, visit the website or call 515-368-9564. Iowa's Students First Education Savings Account (ESA) application for the 2024-25 school year is open and available in your Odyssey Portal beginning at 8:00 am on Tuesday, April 16, 2024. Applications are REQUIRED to be completed ANNUALLY to verify student eligibility through confirmation of lowa residency. Please review additional information below.

- Returning ESA Participants:
 - Annual applications are required to verify Iowa residency.

- Students that received an ESA in the 2023-24 school year are not subject to income requirements to determine ESA eligibility for the 2024-25 school year.
- New ESA Participants:
 - Students that **did not** attend an lowa accredited nonpublic school in the prior year are not subject to income requirements.
 - Students that **did** attend an Iowa accredited nonpublic school in the prior year but did not receive an ESA are subject to income requirements based on 400% of poverty level.
 - Income eligibility requirements by household size are available on the Students First ESA web page under the questions and answers section.
 - Only one ESA application is necessary per family.
 - Siblings may be added to the application of a current participant.
- Application Information
 - Applications are available in English and Spanish.
 - Deadline: Applications will be accepted until Sunday, June 30, 2024 at 11:59 pm.
 - NEW: Immediately following application approval, students will be able to select their school of choice. Once selected, the school will be able to see the student in their Odyssey dashboard.
 - Additional 2024-25 program details and deadlines will be communicated upon application approval.
