This course is designed to meet the requirements for the Substitute Authorization Program. Receiving a Substitute Authorization will allow an individual who holds an associate's degree or

higher or has completed 60 semester hours through a regionally accredited institution to substitute in grades PK-12 for no more than ten consecutive days in a thirty-day period in one job assignment for a regularly assigned teacher who is absent, except in the driver's education classroom. An individual who holds a paraeducator certificate without an associate's degree and completes the Substitute Authorization course will be authorized to substitute only in the special education classroom to which they are assigned.
