- 9) Pastors Report Father Jason Crossen Capital campaign goes live 9/8. Big kick-off weekend. Surpassed 9mil. Info will be widely known by September. Total cost looking like \$40million. Still have to contribute to "On the Rock" campaign. Plan is that dirt is moving this Spring after the crops are out. Russell has been chosen as the contractor. Lots of different committees for moving this forward. Miranda Lawrence has been the main contact between staff and the building committee.
- 10) Principal Report Katie Selden every grade level has an increase. There was a number of 70 going around, for new students, but it's right around 50 new students in K-8. Lost 2 families that was a total of 6 kids. Change in rules for STO money. Rules for STO has changed because of ESA. So the amount of money we can give to IL students is less now, than it has been. STO will go away in the next few years. 27% increase in K-8 enrollment. Talking with teachers about catholic identity. Tighten up/enforce dress code. Asking your support not trying to make kids feel bad, it's just enforcing the dress code. The other one is shoes no slip on tennis shoes. The kids need shoes with laces or velcro. Planning phase for changing the style of report cards. Standards based assessment. Professional development in training on this. New student reporting system JMC will go away, PowerSchool will be the new system. It will change everything from how we gather lunch count every morning, to how we organize contact info for the families. Smile and eyes on Jesus as we transition. Staffing all certified teachers are hired. State of IA has put an emergency order that subs can be hired as temporary teachers for up to a year. Still in the process of hiring 2 aids. Safe environment 3 hours for staff we don't know if this will be a requirement for volunteers in the building. Father Ben said that Paulette is also working on this and says the training video is a much better quality than in the past, and everyone has to take it. It all comes down to timing and when you're Virtus expires. Morgan says his religious ed volunteers only had to do a portion that included a background check.
