Uniforms and SPIRITWEAR

This is the final school year that Lourdes Catholic School logos, sweatshirts, spiritwear will be worn. When we move to St. Joan of Arc we will only wear SJA logos, sweatshirts, spiritwear. To ease the transition, we have introduced SJA uniform and spiritwear. For the upcoming school year, both Lourdes and SJA uniform and spiritwear may be worn. Please see the Dress Code for details.

All shoes worn to school must velcro or tie. The 'bungee' closure is not part of the dress code and these shoes are not allowed. Slip-on tennis shoes are not allowed. This is the same requirement as last school year.

The new Spiritwear and uniform items for St. Joan of Arc have the school logo in designated places. You will notice in the new SJA items that are available that the following guidelines are in effect:

LEFT CHEST decoration (logo) = uniform approved, can be worn any day. FULL FRONT decoration (logo) = spirit wear, can be worn on Fridays only.

Used Uniform (and Spiritwear!) Sale

Prices are \$1/item and \$5/jumper or skirt. Cash accepted or checks made payable to SCCS. All proceeds go back to the school in the Home and School account. You may stop in at school during business hours to shop. The New Family Night and Unpack the Backpack are other times you can shop these items.

A note from Dr. Frega, a Lourdes parent: I hope that you are having a nice summer! I wanted to offer my practice's services for Lourdes families. I run an integrative medical clinic, Ideal Health and Wellness. I have a medical doctor and two family practice nurse practitioners who are available to do school physicals. We will be offering extended hours on Tuesday, August 6 and Tuesday, August 20 until 6 pm for Lourdes families. We also have mental health services with two therapists who specialize in children's psychology.
