5th-8th Grade Choir- Please read!

With our growing enrollment and fantastic participation in band and choir, my schedule has gotten really tight this year! Choir has been moved to after school on the first and third Wednesday of the month from 2:30-3:15 because of this. Uniforms and Spiritwear
