Transportation Reimbursement K-8 Students

If your family lives within an Iowa school district's boundaries, you are eligible for transportation reimbursement. Students who reside within Bettendorf (more than 2 miles from Lourdes), Pleasant Valley, Davenport and North Scott districts are eligible for transportation reimbursement.

Bettendorf (BCSD), Pleasant Valley (PV), Davenport (DCSD), and North Scott forms are provided at each of the links above. You may print the form for the school district within the boundaries you live and send it in to the address at the bottom of your form. You may also email a copy to the appropriate school district. The contact information can be found at the bottom of each form. December 1 is the hard deadline for the first semester, and we know from experience that the school districts do not make any exceptions. Please do not mail or send your form to Lourdes. They must be sent directly to the appropriate school district.
