Altar Serving

My name is Andy Katherman and I lead the Altar Server Ministry at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Parish. A few months back, I spoke with the students about the opportunity of serving at Mass and what a privilege it is to be an Altar Server. Finally, I am opening up the signups with training to commence in December. In short, an Altar Server is a Catholic lay assistant (usually 5th-12th grade) to the Priest and Deacon at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. An Altar Server might performs any of the following action at Mass or another liturgy service:

- Leads the Processional & Recession with the Crucifix
- Carries the Thurible and/or Incense Boat for the Priest
- Assists at a Funeral Mass
- Assists in a <u>Eucharistic Procession</u>
- Assists during Eucharistic Adoration, Benediction, and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- Assists at Stations of the Cross
- Presents the Sacramentary (Missal) for the Collect & Post Communion Prayer
- Presents the candles during the Gospel
- Assists with Gifts/Offertory before Communion
- Rings the bells during the Eucharistic Prayer & Consecration
- PRAYS the Mass with piety and reverence

Do any of these interest your child? Please find the following <u>sign-up</u> form if your child is interested in being an Altar Server.

While the Altar Server training is primarily for our Lourdes Catholic Parish students, those who are Catholic and attend a different parish are certainly welcome to enroll especially if they would like to serve at the school Mass. In order to be an Altar Server at your own parish (such as St John Vianney), please note additional training most likely will be required. Learning to serve at Mass will enlighten students on the many beautiful elements of the liturgy including the "why" and purpose for the movements, postures, and actions of the Priest and Laity. It is also something many students can use to grow in their faith and love of the Eucharist. After enrolling, students will be asked to complete a short online "course" hosted on the website SursumCorda.net (latin for "Lift Up Our Hearts"). This is a preparatory tutorial with videos, rules, guidelines, and instructions relevant for the in-person training which will start in December. I have set the tentative schedule for in-person training for the days below. Attendance will be

required at only one of these dates/times. Please note, additional times will be available should these times not work, but we hope one of the following will be sufficient.

- Wednesday, December 11th (2:30 to 4pm)
- Wednesday, December 18th (2:30 to 4pm)
- Sunday. December 15th (11:45-1:15)
- Sunday, December 22nd (11:45-1:15)
