ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

a. Mrs. Katie Selden - no change in enrollment. H&S family movie night coming up. Working on purchasing with grant money. New link on website for "lead" families - interested new families, is working. We've gotten 10 inquiries. Fr. Rich drafted a letter to SJV families who are worried about losing their preschool with the transition/blend to SJA. SCRA grant received to cover gap funds for the playground. Band and music class being covered by Jondle, Curoe and Kruck through Christmas. Long term sub will be shadowing Jondle next week. Long term sub will start after Xmas when he graduates and gets an official teaching license.

1. PASTOR'S NOTES

a. Pastor (Fr. Jason) Bishop is taking on a strong leadership role. Might change the overall structure of paying for Catholic education, diocese-wide. Pull mortgage for SJA away from parishes. Change tuition model. Currently in a holding pattern, waiting for more information from the Bishop. A lot coming up for Advent - Next Monday confession/adoration/vespers. We will have reconciliation again for a few remaining classes, next Monday, at school. Working on Catholic identity for SJA. This includes work on the appearance and layout of the chapel at the new school. How to use money wisely with statues and things. Working on what the connection between church and school will look like, next year. Children's Word started on Sunday. A few hiccups, might not be every Sunday. Amy Steinke is taking the lead on that.
