
- Giving food, toiletries, or household supplies

#### Transportation Reimbursement K-8 grade

If your family lives within an Iowa school district's boundaries, you are eligible for transportation reimbursement. If you live over 2 miles from Lourdes in the Bettendorf School District you are eligible through BCSD.

Bettendorf (BCSD), Pleasant Valley (PV), Davenport (DCSD), and North Scott forms are provided at each of the links above. You may print the form out for the school district within whose boundaries you live, and send it in to the address at the bottom of your form as soon as you can. You can also email a copy to the appropriate school district. The contact information can be found at the bottom of each form. May 1 is the hard deadline for the second semester. Please do not mail or send your form to Lourdes. Forms must be sent directly to the appropriate school district.

# Scott County Catholic Schools Update

On 4-8-2025 the Iowa Legislature set the ESA (Education Savings Account) rate for the 2025-2026 school year, which allows Scott County Catholic Schools to finalize our tuition rate schedule for the upcoming year. You may note that in some cases this tuition is lower than originally projected. This results from early registrations that indicate significant enrollment increases, continued support from local Catholic parishes, greater opportunity for cost sharing, and guidance from our Diocese.

# Grade School

- Parish Subsidized Student \$ 6,075 Total parent cost = \$150 registration fee.
- Non-Parish Subsidized Student \$8,505 Total parent cost = \$522 tuition and \$150 registration fee. (Families facing economic barriers may apply to the Family Tuition Plan for assistance with tuition.)

**<u>Registration</u>** As mentioned earlier, it is our strong desire to reserve a seat for any returning student who is current on tuition and has paid their \$150 registration fee. If you have not yet registered to return, and feel you have a special circumstance regarding outstanding tuition or payment of registration fees, please contact your school principal to discuss a deadline extension.

**Parish Membership** If you were previously a member of the Catholic faith, we invite you to consider reaffirming your commitment. If you have never been Catholic but are interested in

joining the Church, we encourage you to seek further information. Any local parish will be able to assist you with details on becoming a member of the Catholic community.

**Open Invitation** If you were Catholic in the past, we invite you to consider renewing your commitment to the Catholic faith. If you have never been Catholic but have considered joining The Church, we encourage you to inquire. Any local parish can provide you with more information on becoming Catholic.
